1 Onboarding Process

This instruction should help you to complete the onboarding process for the Outbound Order Book. Therefore the following displayed steps have to be done.




Figure 1: Onboarding process – Overview

1.1 Initial registration

Before the booking of the Outbound Order Book a general registration of an RIO account has to be done. To do so, follow the provided <https://rio.cloud>.

Please note that the person who will do the registration will be automatically the company administrator. As a company administrator you can invite further colleagues to your RIO account (e.g. the whole dispatch department).

After opening the link you will see the following page.

By clicking on the “Visit RIO Platform” button, you will be directed to the Login and register page.

When you don't have an account yet, you can now start with the registration process. Otherwise please proceed with chapter 1.2 . To register a new account click on the link “Register here”.




Figure 3: Login and register page

In the following step you have to select your region.




Figure 4: Register process – step 1

Then fill in your company data.

1.2 Book the OOB in Marketplace

After your successful Login you can follow the link to the RIO marketplace.

You will be redirected to the RIO marketplace.




Figure 6: RIO Marketplace

You should directly be taken to the following page and can register with your VW data.




Figure 7: OOB page in RIO marketplace

In the registration process you will be asked to provide a username, your Volkswagen supplier number¹ and your DUNS-number. Moreover you have to decide whether you would like to use the “Frontend only” or the “Frontend and the interface”.

¹ For your information: The Volkswagen supplier number is the supplier number that is used in business transactions with Volkswagen Group Logistics. This can be found in the contracts and in the supplier master data on the One.KBP (www.vwgroupsupply.com). The input is made as a six-digit number (without leading and ending zeros).

1.3 Authentication

The following step is the authentication of your given data by the Volkswagen Group Logistics. The verification will be done using your E-Mail and your Supplier number (from contract). After the Authentication is done by Volkswagen Group Logistics, your registration is completed.

1.4 Registration completed

Once the registration is completed you will be ready to receive Transport Orders via the OOB.

1.5 Setting up interface

If, during the registration process, you have chosen to use the “Frontend and the interface” you will be given the credentials to set up the interface.

Using the credentials you can then start the implementation of the interface. Therefore a special test API is already set up to support you.

Once the registration is completed and the interface is set up, you will be ready to receive Transport Orders via the interface and the frontend in the Outbound Order Book.
